DETROIT, May 18, 2014 – The Detroit Public Schools Foundation (DPSF) is partnering with Detroit Lions Linebacker Stephen Tulloch and The Stephen Tulloch Foundation to collect camp supplies for students to “Send a Kid to Camp.”

On Wednesday, May 21, 2014 from 11:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., DPSF and the Stephen Tulloch Foundation will be at Happy’s Pizza and Pub, 7170 Orchard Lake Rd in West Bloomfield collecting camp supplies and monetary donations to send kids to the Burt Shurly Camp. Detroit Lions Linebacker Stephen Tulloch will be on-site from 4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. to meet and greet those making donations.

Managed by Detroit Public Schools, the Burt Shurly Camp is an overnight camp 60 miles north of Detroit. The camp is free of charge to Detroit Public Schools students and offers students a six day overnight experience where Michigan certified teachers offer enrichment in Language Arts, Mathematics and Natural Science. Additional emphasis is placed on socialization, character-building, self-reliance and individual creativity.

“Each year hundreds of students are unable to attend the Burt Shurly camp because they lack the necessary supplies for overnight camp, said Dr. Price, President, Detroit Public Schools Foundation.” “We are so excited to partner with Stephen Tulloch and his foundation as we collect camping supplies to send students to camp, said Price.”

Items most needed are sleeping bags, towels, pool shoes and basic toiletries, however monetary donations will be accepted as well.
